We have long blade plastic fins, weight belts, our custom 3.5mm Kairos spearfishing tops, cut resistant gloves, masks, snorkels and Ermes spearguns. These brand new spearguns are built in house by Kairos Spearfishing using top of the line products. If you have your own gear thats great! We actually prefer if you have your own mask and snorkel. We believe it's best to train in what your used to, but it is mandatory to use long blade fins for safety and hunting reasons.
